

FAST FACTS ABOUT MALARIA

Almost 8 out of 10 people who come back to the UK with malaria are of Black African origin



Most UK travellers who get malaria catch it in Nigeria, Ghana or Sierra Leone



Sickle cell trait does not make you immune to malaria



Being born or growing up in Africa does not make you immune to malaria



Having malaria before doesn't make you immune- you can catch it over and over again

AFRICANS AGAINST MALARIA

Most African countries are high malaria risk- use malaria preventive medicine and bite prevention.



Malaria prevention medicine is over 90% effective when used correctly.



Malaria prevention medicine can be as little as £20 for a 2 week trip.



You can get malaria during dry season and in cities.
